Basic conversation:

Hello! = Kon-nichi-wa!

What is your name? = O-na/ma/e o
o/shi/e/te/ku/da/sa/i.

I am ~ = Watashi wa (your first name) desu.

How are you? = O-genki desuka.

Yes, I am fine. = Hai, genki desu.

And are you fine too? = Anata mo o-genki desuka.

Yes, I am fine, too = Hai, watashi mo genki desu.

Vocabulary: o-namae= (your) name oshiete kudasai=please tell (me) watashi=I
desu = a sentence ends with "desu."
genki = healthy anata = you hai = yes desuka = a question sentence ends with "desuka."
